**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX
MILLAGE RATES FOR 2025**


WHEREAS, Washington County, acting through its Board of Commissioners, is empowered by the Georgia Constitution and by State Law to set and impose ad valorem property taxes; and

WHEREAS, the County has previously adopted, in compliance with State Law, a budget for fiscal year 2025 and has further satisfied all requirements for giving notice of and publishing information regarding the levy of taxes as may be required by O.C.G.A § 48-5-32 and other laws.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that for calendar year 2025 there is levied on all property in Washington County subject to taxation, ad valorem tax of the following:





1. WCBOE Maintenance and Operation tax be set at 13.398 mills to net \$12,146,510.




